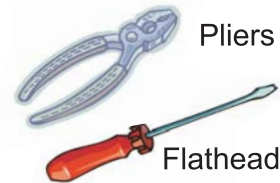

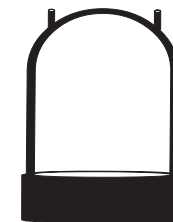

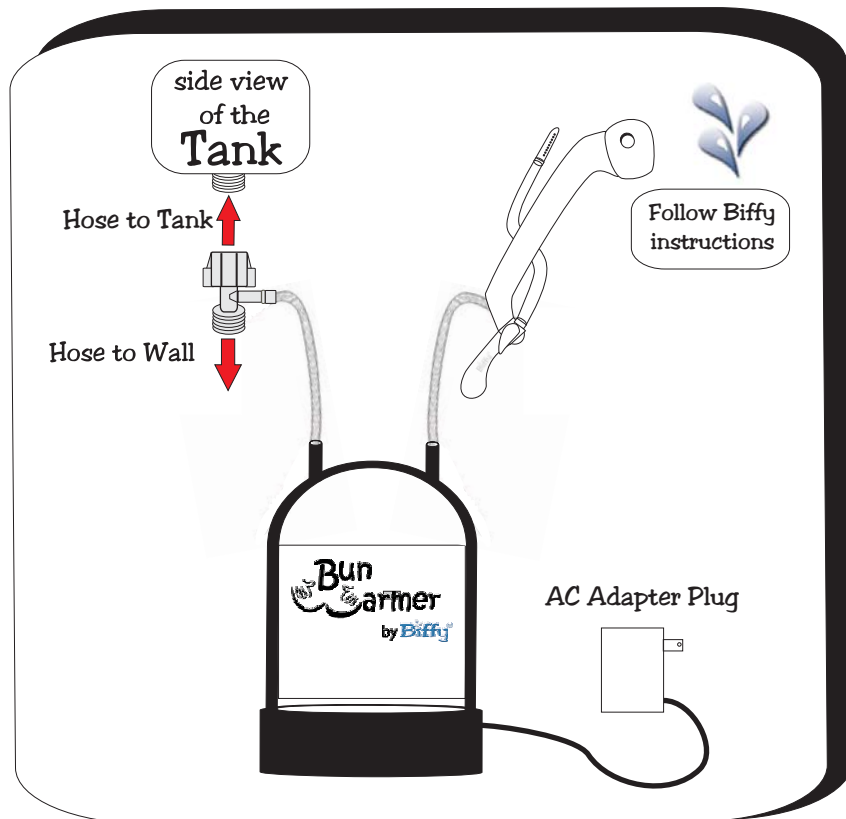

WARNINGS:

- The Biffy Bun Warmer is not a toy. It will heat up and may appear hot to the touch. It is safe to leave your Biffy Bun Warmer running continuously 24 hours a day, but it should be used responsibly at all times.
- Do not use this appliance for other than its intended use.
- Do not store your Biffy Bun Warmer while hot or still connected to the power supply.
- Do not immerse the Biffy Bun Warmer in water or any other liquid.
- Do not allow the cord set to come into contact with water during operation.
- This product should not be used outdoors.
- Do not place the Biffy Bun Warmer in a location where it may fall into a tub or shower, or otherwise become immersed in water; and if the Biffy Bun Warmer falls into water, immediately unplug it. Do not reach into the water.

Please Read ALL installation instructions
carefully prior to installation.

Step 1 - Connect to Water Supply

Turn off the water supply at the wall. Unscrew the water supply line and insert the **Biffy** T-adapter between the tank and the supply line. Tighten all fittings.

Step 2 - Attach to Biffy A - New Biffy

Screw the brass barb, at the end of the hose of your new Biffy, onto the available spout of the Bun Warmer tank. Make sure to tighten completely with pliers. Please follow the Biffy installation instructions to attach your Biffy to the toilet. Turn on the water supply at the wall to fill the Bun Warmer reservoir. Plug the AC adapter into your nearest electrical outlet.

B - Existing Biffy

Cut the water line approximately two inches from the brass clamp at the Biffy T-Adapter end. Place the hose clamp over the hose connected to the Biffy. Push hose onto barb of Bun Warmer. Tighten clamp over barb using a phillips screwdriver. **Please ensure hose clamp is sufficiently tightened, as the American Biffy Company, Ltd. is not responsible for any leaks.** Turn on the water supply at the wall to fill the Bun Warmer reservoir. Plug the AC adapter into your nearest electrical outlet.

IMPORTANT: Check for any water leakage. As with all plumbing appliances, if your Biffy Bun Warmer is unattended for a great period of time, we advise the water supply be turned off.
